APPLICATION INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

The N.O.F.I. Humanitarian Award is open to graduating secondary students within Frontier School Division and Frontier School Division Home Placement graduates.

Award recipients must meet the following criteria:

- Involvement in voluntary humanitarian work,
- Graduating High School student of Frontier School Division or graduating student of Frontier School Division Home Placement Program, or
- A resident of a Frontier School Division community who is transported to a non-Frontier high school by Frontier School Division and is a graduate.

HOW TO APPLY

In order to be considered for the N.O.F.I. Humanitarian Award, students must submit a completed application form, two references and an official high school transcript that indicates the final anticipated graduation credits.

The application form and accompanying documents must be post marked by May 30th of each year. Send completed application to:
